A BYLAW TO CLOSE A PUBLIC HIGHWAY

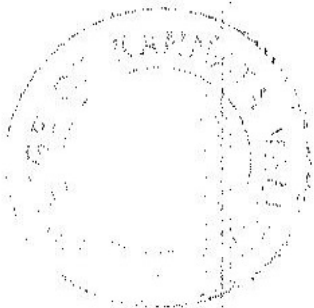
The council of the Village of Kannata Valley in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. That portion of a public highway within the Village of Kannata Valley described as follows:

All that portion of the Original Road Allowance lying Westerly from and adjacent to the South West Quarter of Section 17, Township 21, Range 21 West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, described as: being bounded on the North by a line joining the North East corner of Lot A Plan FW1465 to the point of intersection of the South Easterly production of the North Easterly limit of Beach Avenue on Plan FW1465 and the Westerly boundary of the South West Quarter of Section 17, Township 21, Range 21, West of the Second Meridian, Saskatchewan, and bounded on the South by the Northerly bank of Last Mountain Lake;

Commonly known as the portion of the access road at the eastern boundary of the village, from a line north of the pumphouse to the water's edge,

is hereby closed.
