Crime Neighbourhood Watch

CRIME NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH is a program aimed at reducing crime in the community. It involves getting to know one's neighbours; it involves good neighbours working together, alert to the potential for crime and willing to look out for one another's interests.

Neighbours working together through a neighbourhood watch program can combat crime before it starts. The program can also help to coordinate the efforts of the police and the community to track down criminals when crimes are committed.

HERE IS HOW IT WORKS...

Kannata Valley is divided into five zones. Each zone has one captain and one assistant and is overseen by a coordinator. When a crime occurs in any zone, we ask that:

1. The reporting resident FIRST notifies the RCMP. Once reported THEN call your designated zone captain.
2. The captain will then notify the program coordinator who in turn will notify all the other zone captains.
3. Finally, the residents in each zone will be made aware of the criminal activity.

Help to create a secure environment for your family, home and property.

WE invite you to be an active participant in keeping our community crime free.

IF you notice anything suspicious, document the following: a description of people acting suspiciously and/or the make, model, colour and license plate number of any strange vehicles in the vicinity.

IF you have a concern that a house party may get out of control, or feel uncomfortable about any situation that may arise, please call the police and your Neighbourhood Watch Committee Zone Captain immediately.

IF you are going away for a length of time, leave your destination, contact number, return date and a key to your premises with a friend or neighbour.
